Reports have appeared in the media that Pakistani players will not be able to participate in the Indian Premier League, scheduled to be held in India in 2010, due to non-issuance of visas by the High Commission of India, Islamabad.

The High Commission was approached by the Pakistan Cricket Board for issuance of visa to only one player (Sohail Tanvir), while three other players submitted visa applications to the High Commission of India in wellington. These visa applications are being processed.

The High Commission of India was not advised about any deadline for issuing visas to Pakistani players either by IPL Organizing Committee or the Pakistan Cricket Board.
